Meeting Presentation Summary and Guest Speaker

Presentation Summary:

Director Fremier will provide an overview of the Metropolitan Transportation Commission and the Association of Bay Area Governments; in his presentation, the director will discuss the genesis of both agencies, the merger of the two agencies, who's on the respective boards and the services they provide to the 9 county Bay Area.

Guest Speaker:

Andrew B. Fremier, Executive Director, Metropolitan Transportation Commission

Andrew Fremier is the executive director of the Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) and the Association of Bay Area Governments (ABAG), overseeing a consolidated staff of some 380 who support both the transportation planning, funding and coordinating agency for the San Francisco Bay Area and the council of governments for the region's nine counties and 101 cities and towns. Among many other responsibilities, MTC and ABAG jointly develop and update the Bay Area's long-range transportation, housing and land-use plan, which guides the agencies' policy and investment decisions. The current plan, known as Plan Bay Area 2050, was adopted in 2021 and identifies 35 strategies to make the region better connected, more affordable, healthier and more economically vibrant.

Before his 2023 selection by the Commission to serve as executive director for MTC and ABAG, Mr. Fremier had worked since 2005 as a deputy executive director. Prior to joining MTC, he had a 20-year career at the California Department of Transportation, during which he led the Toll Bridge and Highway construction program, guided development of the successful Toll Bridge Seismic Retrofit Program and served as Chief Deputy District Director for Caltrans District 4.

Mr. Fremier is a licensed engineer in California and the current president of the International Bridge, Tunnel and Turnpike Association. He holds a Bachelor's degree in civil engineering from California Polytechnic State University, San Luis Obispo.
