Speaker Bio

Aundi Mevoli, Program Intern

Aundi began her internship at Baykeeper in September 2020 with the science team. She has worked on projects related to sea level rise and toxic site inundation, advocated with cities on general plan language, and urged cities to implement regenerative landscape practices. Prior to her work in the environmental field, Aundi worked as a chiropractor and educator in the health field. Aundi earned her MNR in Natural Resource Management and Global Sustainability from Virginia Tech. She holds a BA from the University of San Francisco and has a Doctor of Chiropractic degree from Life West Chiropractic College.

Jon Rosenfield, Senior Scientist

Jon joined Baykeeper in 2019 as our senior scientist. He is responsible for integrating the best available science into Baykeeper policy positions and legal arguments to protect San Francisco Bay. Prior to joining Baykeeper, Jon worked for over 10 years protecting the Bay's endangered fishes and commercial fisheries as a conservation biologist with The Bay Institute. Jon has conducted scientific research and translated science for attorneys, policymakers, and the public since the early 1990s, when he first encountered San Francisco Bay and its watershed as a research associate for the Sierra Club Legal Defense Fund (now Earthjustice). Jon earned his Ph.D. in biology from the University of New Mexico. He also holds a BS in natural resource ecology from Cornell University and an MS in resource management and conservation biology from the University of Michigan.
