Presentation Topic

Resilient Alameda Shoreline: Connecting Regional and Local Shoreline Adaptation Plans

Senior staff from the San Francisco Bay Conservation and Development Commission (BCDC) will discuss how SB 272 (Laird, 2023) requires local governments to create sea level rise adaptation plans and mandates that BCDC create a Regional Shoreline Adaptation Plan. To assist local governments along the Bay shoreline, BCDC is using its voluntary and collaborative Bay Adapt Program to develop guidelines upon which those local resilience plans will be based; the guidelines will be finalized by the end of 2024.
